Since 1999, I've worked for both agency and product development businesses—blending architecture, team management, and cross-functional collaboration to ship software.

### **Fillmer Innovation Group** (June 2017 – Present)

#### *Product Owner & Engineering Manager*

- Built a platform that performs geolocation checks at the time of a credit card transaction. Formed a development team, worked with the CEO and Product Owner to refine the product, and outlined the system architecture and tech stack.
- Spent several years with a supplier of digital media to libraries reworking various legacy applications. Their e-commerce platform is private, available to library systems that are customers, and was built on a single Java platform. We rebuilt it to leverage React, Kafka, GraphQL, Node.js, and Redis. This was a multi-year project with 15+ developers.

### **CA Technologies** (November 2016 – May 2017)

#### *Engineering Team Lead*

- Created a visualization tool for Docker systems that would allow the creation of Docker Compose configurations. A prototype had been created, I joined to build out a production-ready frontend and ship version 1.0.
- Created a team of two other frontend developers, mentoring them as well as directly contributing to the codebase with reference implementations.
- Contributed the initial GraphQL interface for the backend team.

### *Engineering Team Lead*

- Ran the frontend team, translating designs into functional prototypes for a variety of healthcare and financial businesses.
- Managed a three-person frontend development team.
- Pioneered an iterative approach of working with clients directly.

- I have been active in software development since 1999. Over this time period I worked for several development and design agencies in both Alabama and Colorado.
